


General Information:

Parking is available at the South Garage: 2366 Jim Calhoun Way, Storrs CT 06268. Once parked, please bring your ticket to the registration desk to be validated. Parking costs are included in your registration.

Parking in the Nathan Hale Inn lot is for overnight guests only. Hotel parking permits may be obtained from the front desk at check-in. The address of the Nathan Hale Inn is 855 Bolton Road, Storrs, CT 06268.



Getting to UConn By Car:

I-84 east to exit 68. Turn right onto Route 195 south. I-84 west to exit 68. Turn left onto Route 195 south.

From I-84:

Travel south on Route 195 straight through the intersection with Route 32. At the intersection of Routes 195 and Route 44, turn right. At the first light, turn left onto Discovery Drive. Continue straight through the first light (N. Eagleville Road), then 2-3 stop signs. Turn right onto Calhoun Way. The entrance to the SOUTH parking garage will be on your left.

From Willimantic Area:

Travel north on Route 195 until you arrive in Storrs Center. Turn left onto Bolton Road. Follow Bolton Road to the stop sign. Proceed right onto Hillside Road. Continue straight through the first stop sign. At the second stop sign turn left onto Calhoun Way. The entrance to the SOUTH parking garage will be on your left.



By Bus: Peter Pan buses stop at designated stops on the South end of campus, outside of West and Alumni residence halls. Please see their website for more information on schedules and fares.




By Train: Hartford's Union Station (HFD) is serviced by Amtrak's Northeast Regional and Vermonter routes. Union Station is located about 30 minutes away from the Storrs campus.

Walking directions to Rome Commons: Upon parking, exit onto Hillside Road. Turn right on Hillside Road. Continue to the first stop sign and walk to the left onto Gilbert Road. Walk to the right onto the Gilbert Road Extension. Walk to the left at the circular parking lot. Rome Commons will be straight ahead; the Nathan Hale Inn is on your right.
